I draw inspiration from the Bhagavad Gita, which offers timeless lessons for us all:

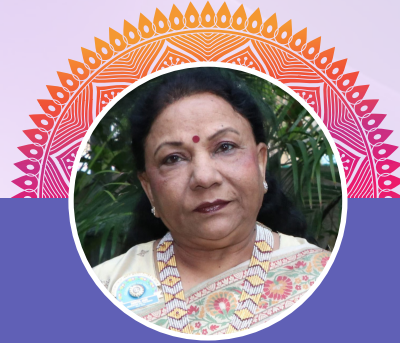
- **Selfless Service:** Focus on serving others with compassion, not personal gain.

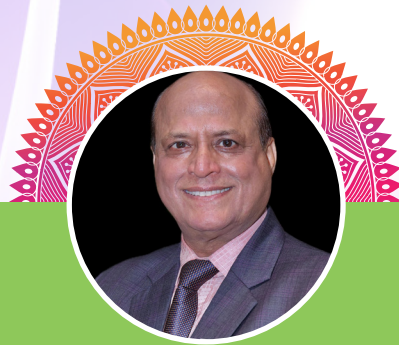

District Chairman's Message



My dear Inner Wheel members,

It gives me immense pleasure to Congratulate each one of you for the exemplary performance over the past happening six months of the Shagun year 2024-25. Every Club and member has worked relentlessly in the pursuit of doing several worthwhile projects to give something back to the Society. Am honoured and grateful to have a dedicated team at District and the 78 clubs in the most versatile Districts of Inner Wheel in India. This is an year of renewed actions, possibilities, changes, mission, vision, horizons of hope, togetherness and strengthened joys.

I always mention the words of Rabindranath Tagore, *"I slept and dreamt that life was joy. I awoke and saw that life was service. I acted and behold service was joy."* We embarked on our journey 6 months back in our 101st year of Inner Wheel with the IIW theme "Heartbeat for Humanity". Every Beat Counts, Every Action matters". It is a call to action, a reminder of our shared responsibility to make the world a better place. The Heartbeat signifies life and Heartbeat for Humanity refers to the pulse of kindness, the rhythm of service and the collective effort to uplift and empower those around us. Together we can keep the Heartbeat of Humanity strong and vibrant.

The Theme for the District is "Aabha" signifying glow, luster, shine. It refers to an aura, the unseen spiritual energy field that surrounds all living things. We have embraced the changes of the next century of Inner Wheel and have embarked on our service and spiritual journey, energised to see our aspirations come to fruition. In Sanskrit, "chakra" means "disk" or "wheel" and refers to the energy centers in your body. These wheels or disks of spinning energy, each correspond to certain nerve bundles and major organs. Each of our major District events have been named after the 7 Chakras.

The District has undertaken four major projects –

The Urban Medical Project :

District is donating a 5-part hematology cell counter (two latest machines alongwith the required reagents for one year) which is an urgent requirement at LT Medical College & General Hospital, Sion. The department of Pathology provides following laboratory services - Surgical pathology, Autopsy, Cytopathology, Hematology, Blood Bank, Chemical pathology, Clinical pathology, Emergency lab services.

The Urban Vocational Project :

S.H.E.D has a skill training centre for girls and women at Kalina and needs immediate upgrade. District has taken the initiative to upgrade the centre involving a series of strategic changes and steps to ensure the facility meets current industry standards and effectively serves its trainees. Specifically, the additions/improvements implemented are -

- Infrastructure Enhancement (Modernize facilities by upgrading classrooms)
- Curriculum Development (Revise existing courses & introduce New Programs)

The Rural Girls Hostel Project :

District is constructing a 3-storied girls hostel at Madhavrao Kane Ashramshala at Deogaon, Wada which will house 200 girl students. This hostel will be complete with basic amenities, toilet block on each floor, open area for serving food/ play area at ground level. The existing girls hostel block is also being revamped to improve the condition. The hostel will be ready for inauguration by end Feb/ early March 2025.

The Rural Medical Project:

Six zones of District 314 conducted monthly medical camps at the Palghar Medical Centre, established in 2022-23 by District 314 to serve nearby tribal villages. These initiatives aim to create a lasting impact in education, health, and sustainability

The District and the Clubs have put in their best efforts with a vision filled with enthusiasm, energy and power to identify the needs and executed projects in every focus and thrust areas defined by Association President (covering areas under CELEBRATE, CELEBRATE LIFE & CELEBRATE INNER WHEEL) & IIW President (Cervical cancer prevention, elderly care, environment, rainwater harvesting, branding)

- Environment & Publicize Inner Wheel have been the focal point this year. A massive Kandeel with 30,000 recycled plastic bottles was displayed at Cooperage grounds for 4 weeks publicizing IW District 314.
- Joyful Journey, District Rally – Anahata & District Seminar – Vishuddha saw enthusiastic participation by members.
- Surakshit Bachpan & Sparsh-Ek-Ehsaas, our ongoing projects for many years saw a growth in volunteers and sessions.
- A mass marriage for tribals is being held in February 2025 under Sahara & Sambal

As we move into the second half of the Shagun year, several new projects are lined up in addition to reaching out to more beneficiaries in the focus areas. Second half looks very exciting with Club Presidents firmly in their saddles, rearing to put in their best performance to take their respective clubs to a new high cumulatively culminating into a new high for the District. I also look forward to active participation in the upcoming Triennial at Delhi.

I invite all of you to progress and flourish as we still have goals and dreams that we need to fulfill. All it takes is the willingness to be a part of it! We will do it with renewed energy, a spirit of optimism and unwavering dedication having embraced the guiding principles of IW friendship and service with empathy, collaboration, innovation, resilience and gratitude.

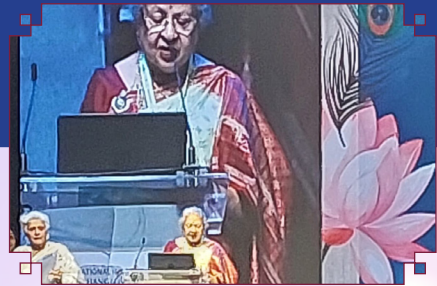

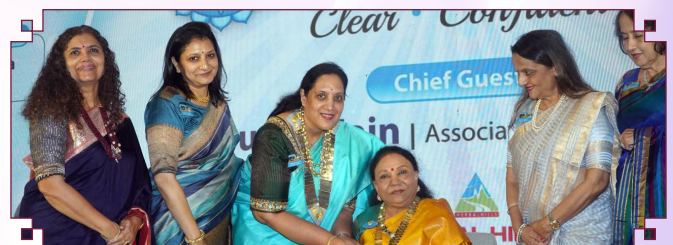

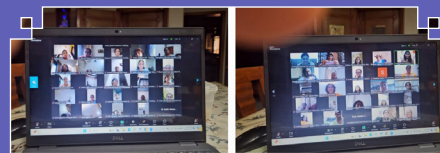

IWDist 314 project has surpassed its feat in last 6 months. Sparsh team has empowered 41,093 students, 4,245 adult 775 sessions across 197 schools. As demand from schools were high for the project we took some steps.

- 1) Special training on POC SO Law , online on 14th Sept for 100 volunteers.
- 2) 2 days ONLINE training for our District and Interdistrict new volunteers was conducted on 30th Sept and 1st Oct . 119 volunteers registered.
- 3) 2 orientations by Chief coordinator Surekha Punamiya were conducted on 10th Oct and 9th Dec for new volunteers to instil confidence to conduct Safe / Unsafe sessions.

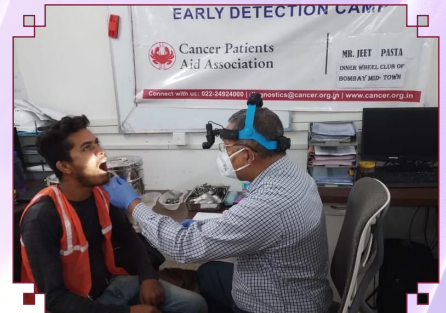
